ELI/ELL/ESL Placement Test Information

Lab Rules

Please note the following rules for testing:

- No personal paper – you must use what is supplied by the testing area
- No food or drinks
- Cell phones and other electronic devices including smart watches must be turned off
- Back packs and purses must be placed under the desk
- No books/notebooks of any kind are allowed in the testing room
- No personal calculators may be used, the calculator for Math is provided within your test
- No talking in the testing room
- All papers must be returned to the testing desk at the conclusion of the test

If you need the attention of a staff member during your test, please contact the Proctor in the testing room, or the staff at the front desk. Staff are unable to answer specific questions about the test, or provide any additional information regarding the test questions. When you are finished testing, return to the Assessment Office front counter to retrieve your scores and placement recommendation.

The CaMLA English Placement Test is a computerized **60 minute** timed test. You must take this test if you have graduated from middle school in a non-English speaking country.

There are 80 questions divided into 4 parts:

1. Listening comprehension
2. Grammatical knowledge
3. Vocabulary range
4. Reading comprehension

Listening comprehension is the **first** part. You will only hear each question **ONCE** and you can **NOT** go back and listen again.

Re-testing

- You may take the CaMLA EPT a second time after 24 hours. The higher of your two scores will be used to place you in a class.
- If you wish to take the test for the third and final time, you must wait for three (3) months before doing so.
- If you are currently enrolled in the ELI or in an ESL course, you may not test again until two (2) weeks before final exams. The placement test cannot be used to substitute for course performance.
- Test results expire after one calendar year. If you have not been enrolled as a student for one academic year or longer, regardless of how many times you have already taken the placement test, you must re-test and then enroll in the level indicated.
